Hello Everyone

In response to parent feedback and in light of the government's announcement that we are all allowed to exercise more freely, we are writing to update you on the changes we are making to home learning tasks that we provide for children.

These changes will come in to effect from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May.

Each week, there will be a Home Learning Grid provided for the children, which offers a range of tasks to complete over the week. There is a mix of daily tasks and choice tasks, to enable flexibility.

These grids, and the accompanying learning will be available for children to access on the both Trent Vale's and Beeston Ryland's websites. You will be able to access links here to on line learning alongside work sheets to down load.

In addition to this, paper pack versions of the grids and tasks will be available for you to collect initially from Trent Vale Infant School.

You will be able to collect the packs on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> May and also on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May.

They will be left in year group boxes under the bike shed at Trent Vale.

We will expect everyone to adhere to stringent social distancing measures when collecting the packs. Please recognise that you will not be able to enter the school building, and all contact with staff continues to be by either phone or email.

Teachers would like to be able to see what the children have been doing so please continue to email samples of the children's work to their class teacher.

There will be no home learning set for the half term week beginning the 25<sup>th</sup> May.

Going forward a pack of work will be available each week for children's home learning. A text will be sent to you to inform you of when and where they can be collected.

We hope this new approach offers the structure to learning, which many of you asked for. However if you have your own pathway through home learning and this is working for you, please feel free to continue this.
